

Regional Beef Research Committees

NABRC comprises 11 Regional Beef Research Committees across Queensland, the Northern Territory and the northern regions of Western Australia.

The primary role of each regional committee is to identify problems and needs that may be solved by research, development, education and training as well as to facilitate the dissemination of research results to producers in their region.

Member Selection Criteria

- 1. Must live and work in a commercial beef enterprise and be actively engaged in aspects of RD&A in the region.
- 2. Demonstrated producer and other relevant networks.
- 3. Knowledge of the NABRC and RBRC structure and functions.
- 4. Be prepared to act as industry and community advocates on grassfed beef RD&A issues
- 5. Capacity and flexibility to attend two RBRC meetings per year and if required be involved in regional activities. Sitting fees and expenses are paid for RBRC meetings.
